Dilation Drops Notification

This office uses drops that will alter the size of the pupil. This is known as dilation. Dilating drops can cause a variety of problems including but not limited to: blurred vision at distance and near, sensitivity to light, poor depth perception, headaches and generally reduced functioning.

We use dilating drops to thoroughly evaluate the inside part of the eye and this is considered a necessary procedure for most new patients. We also perform dilation at certain follow-up visits.

Since dilating drops can significantly affect your functioning for the day and may prevent you from driving safely, we recommend that you consider having a driver come with you. If you have any concerns about dilating drops, the technical staff will be happy to discuss this procedure with you.
